GREENHITHE VOLUNTEER FIRE BRIGADE

Winter Fire Safety

Winter brings a unique set of fire dangers and weather related hazards that you need to be aware of. Follow these fire and emergency safety tips.

Heaters and clothes dryers

- Remember the 'heater metre' rule: keep flammable materials at least one metre away from any heat sources. And it's one heater or larger appliance per plug no more.
- Never cover heating appliances or store objects on top of them.
- Don't overload clothes dryers and clean the lint filter after each load cycle.

Fireplaces and chimneys

- Always use a fireguard or spark-guard when using an open fire.
- Never throw rubbish into the fireplace particularly batteries and aerosol cans.
- Always empty ashes and ashtrays into a metal bin and pour water over them before disposal. Remember that ashes can take up to 5 days to cool.

Electric blankets

- Replace your electric blanket every 5 years with newer heat-protected models.
- Don't place heavy objects on the bed while the blanket is on.
- Make sure the blanket is always flat on the bed and that controls or cords are not
 twisted or caught between the mattress and the base of the bed. Twisted cords are a
 common cause of electric blanket fires.

Remember fire moves incredibly fast – a house fire can kill within three minutes. Know your safe evacuation routes from a fire, tsunami or flood. Practice these with family, friends, and neighbours.

Mitigating floods

Organise alternative places to stay with family, friends or neighbours if you can't get home or need to evacuate. Be aware of slips, fallen trees and power lines that may cut you off.

Thank you Greenhithe! Over the past couple of months, the community has come together and planted around 5000 native plants! These plants will grow over the next few years and become important food sources for our native birds and provide homes for all sorts of New Zealand wildlife.

Once a tree has been planted, we need to ensure it survives. Living in an urban environment, there are many introduced plants that easily spread their seed to our reserves. Typically, introduced plants grow faster than our natives and some have the ability to smother, strangle or outcompete our native trees. We need your help to care for our planted areas. Come and join a regular volunteer group or contact us & we can let you know how you can help. Together we can make sure our native plants survive and provide a thriving habitat for our native wildlife.






